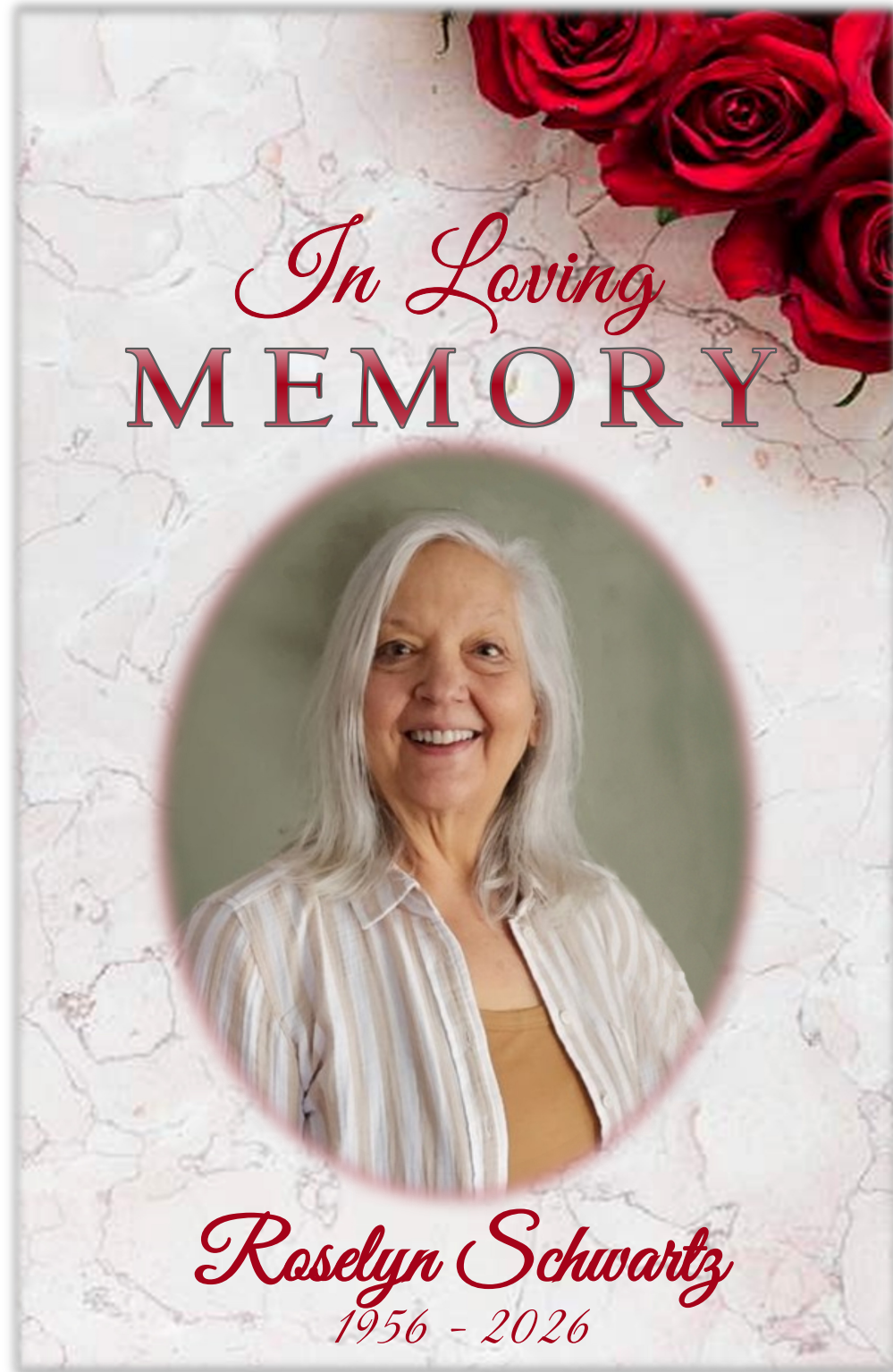
Rose was a devoted member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Great Bend, North Dakota, where her faith was an important part of her life.
