## Bruce Edward Owens

Bruce E. Owens, 85, of McPherson, KS, peacefully passed away in his sleep on Thursday, December 26, 2024, at his home in McPherson.

Bruce was born March 12, 1939, in Speed, KS, the son of Harry E. and Katherine A. (Heikes) Owens.
