If others wonder why I'm missin'

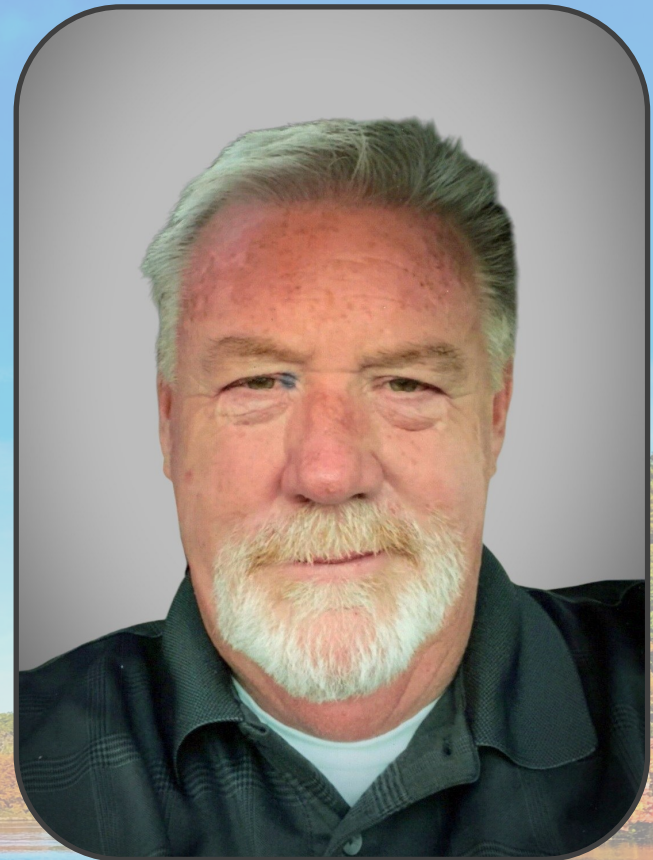
