In Loving Memory of Our Brother...


We did get to say goodbye, dear brother, to hold your hand, unlike so many others. We saw the peace upon your face, and felt God's comfort in that place.

We laughed, we cried, we shared our love, and prayed for strength from up above. Your voice, your smile, your joking ways will live in us through all our days.








You weren't just our brother—you were our guide, our protector, our friend, always by our side. Through ups and downs, both far and near, you made life better just being here.
