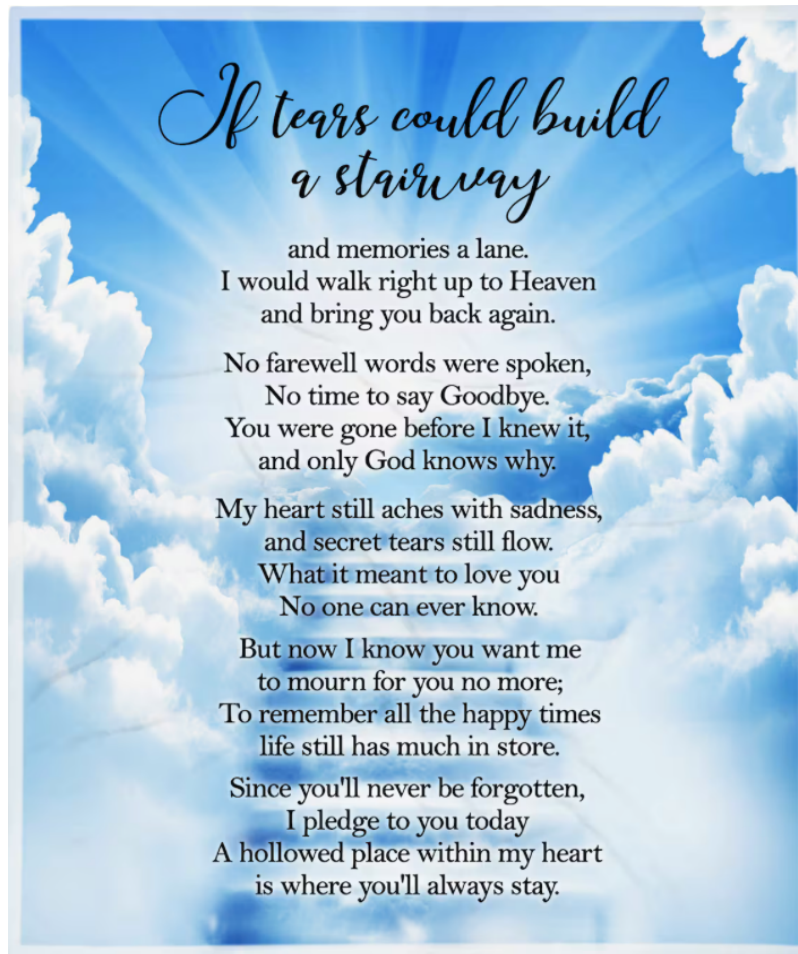


Acknowledgement
