a time to be silent, and a time to speak.

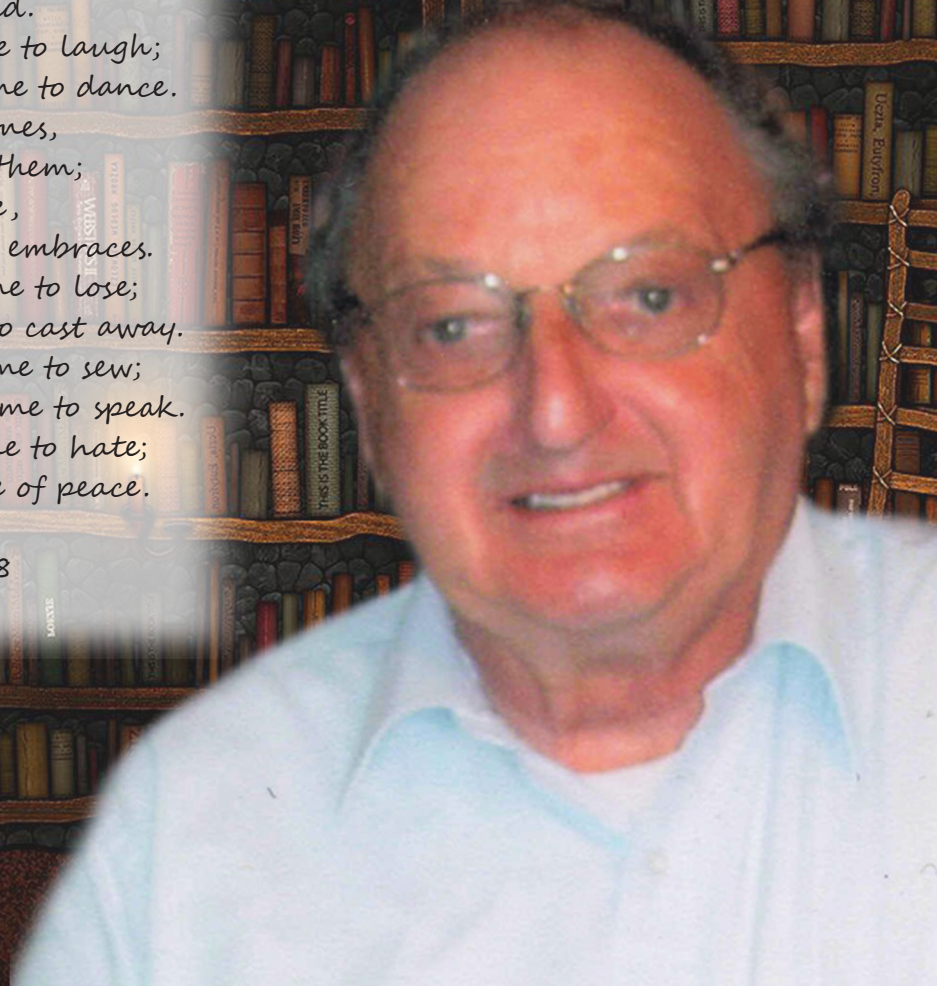
