The man that we call Dad.

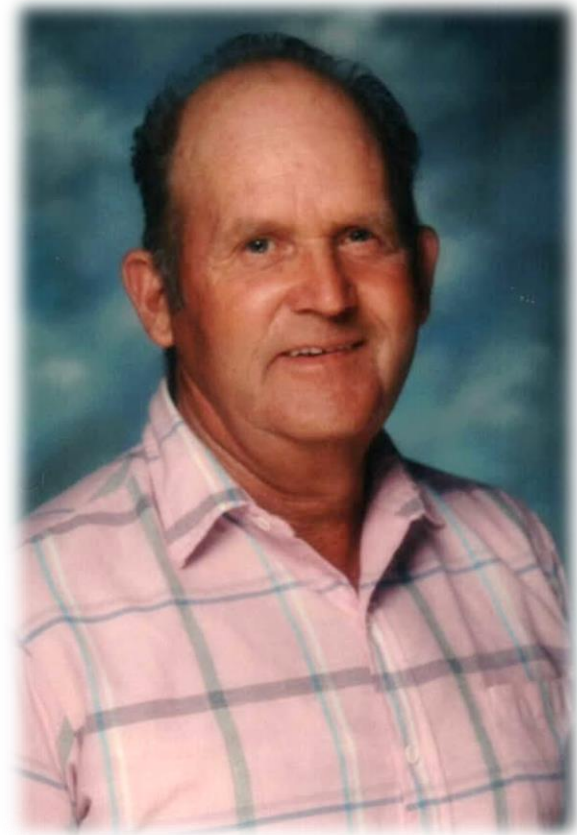
