He leadeth me beside the still waters.

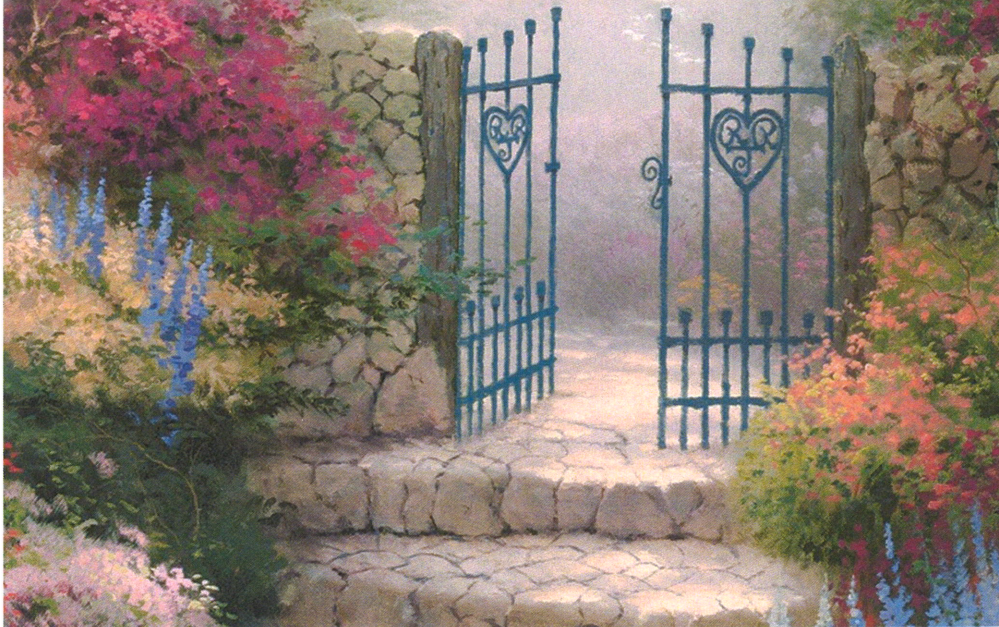
*He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the
