



REFLECTIONS OF LIFE


Ardella was born January 19, 1946, to Less Kelly and Jessie Mae Richmond. She was the sixth child born of this union.

Or make it turn real slow




Until We Meet Again

Until we meet again.










As I Sit In Heaven


