A devout Christian, *Carrie* was of the Pentecostal faith. For the past decade, she worshipped at her new church home, Madison Church of God. During the end of her life, she was still concerned about her family and their salvation, for she stated, “I can’t go to Heaven yet, not without my family.” She has given her family a legacy to build on and one to be immensely proud of.
