





He then worked as a crane operator for 10 years. Prior to retirement, he was an employee of Co-op Inc.

Loren attained 4th degree in the Knights of Columbus, where he also served a term as Grand Knight. He served 26 years on the Elliot Hose Co. #1 Fire Department. He was also an EMT for 6 years.

Loren died Friday, January 31, 2025 at Sr. James Care Center in Yankton. He was 87 years old.
