**Dale Ralph Beyer** was born on July 29, 1937, in Holloway, Minnesota, to Elmer and Laura (Melchert) Beyer. Dale attended Country School through 8th grade and continued Ag School through most of 11th grade. He left school to help his father on the family farm.

On February 6, 1959, Dale enlisted in the National Guard. He proudly served his country as a sharpshooter and cook and received an honorable discharge on February 5, 1961.

Dale was united in marriage to Joyce Kenyon on October 2, 1959, in Morris, Minnesota. Their union was blessed with four children, and together they built a life centered on faith, hard work, and family.

In the early 1960s, Dale and Joyce moved to the Graceville area, where Dale worked for farmer until 1976. He and his family relocated to Morris, where he worked on building truck boxes, doing mechanical and welding at Arvid Beyer Truck Shop. During the mid-1980s he then continued his career as a mechanic at Lembcke's Garage through mid-1990's. In 1992, Dale and Joyce made their home in the Donnelly area.
