Life for Treliese has been full of tremendous trials, tribulations, victories, and successes. She was a member of Tabernacle of Praise Church of God in Christ.

She was a Godfearing and hard-working woman who took NO MESS from anyone. Her humor and how she protected those that she loved will NEVER be forgotten. Though she had a junior high school education, the favor of the Lord rested upon her life, allowing her to obtain good jobs. Treliese went back to school hoping to obtain her high school diploma. When she received her first 3 credits, she was so proud and so were we. Unfortunately, she fell sick and could no longer continue school. She had a dream to open a "Christian Club/Lounge.

She continued to work from home during her sickness until she could no longer. Her advice to her loved ones was to "never be sick and poor, to never neglect health for a job." Treliese selflessness allowed her to be the caregiver for her dying mother causing her kidneys to get worse. Her family was her pride and joy. Her love language was giving certain family members the title MONKEY, DAWG, or HEIFA.

As a child, she endured some suffering that gave her a love for protecting children. Her strength was GOD GIVEN. Treliese was the pistol the family would either pull out and then realize that they shouldn't have pulled it out, but after she was released TRUST ME, a memory and laughter was next on the menu. She was loved by many. There is so much that can be told, but it would turn into a book instead of an obituary.

She was preceded in death by her sister Chantra Walker and brother Jadie Hall Jr.
