

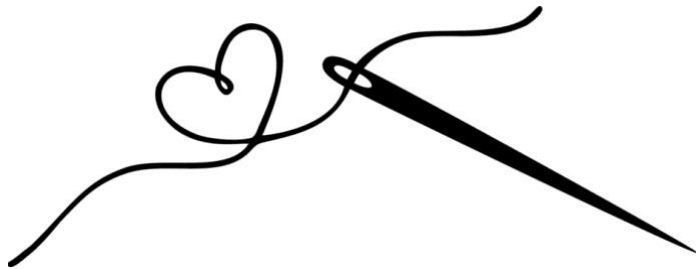
Sewing was her pride and joy,

doing what she loved all year.

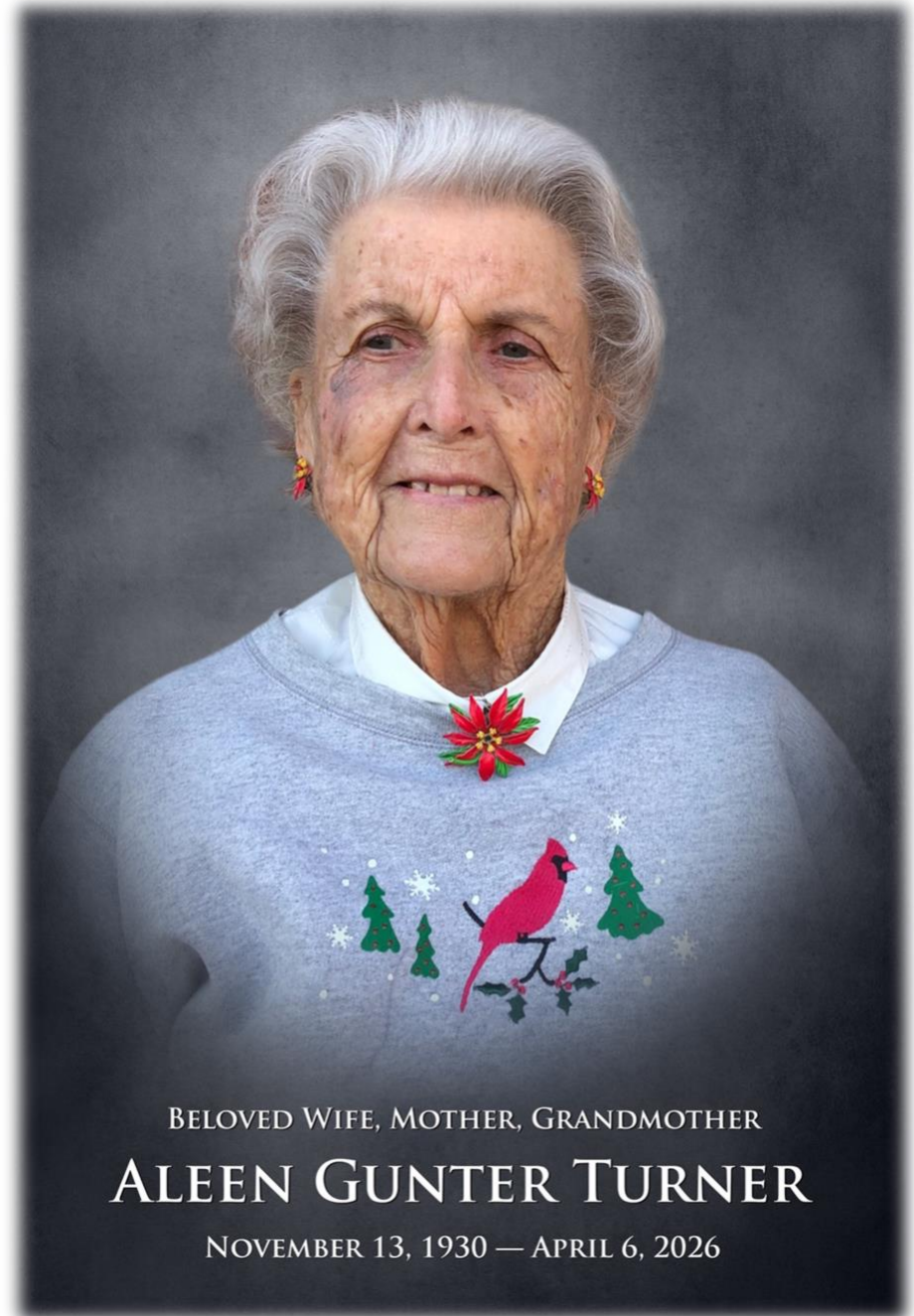
Buttons and zippers in their glory,
