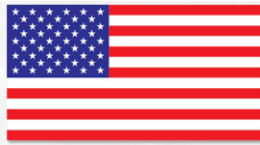


Jason's Story

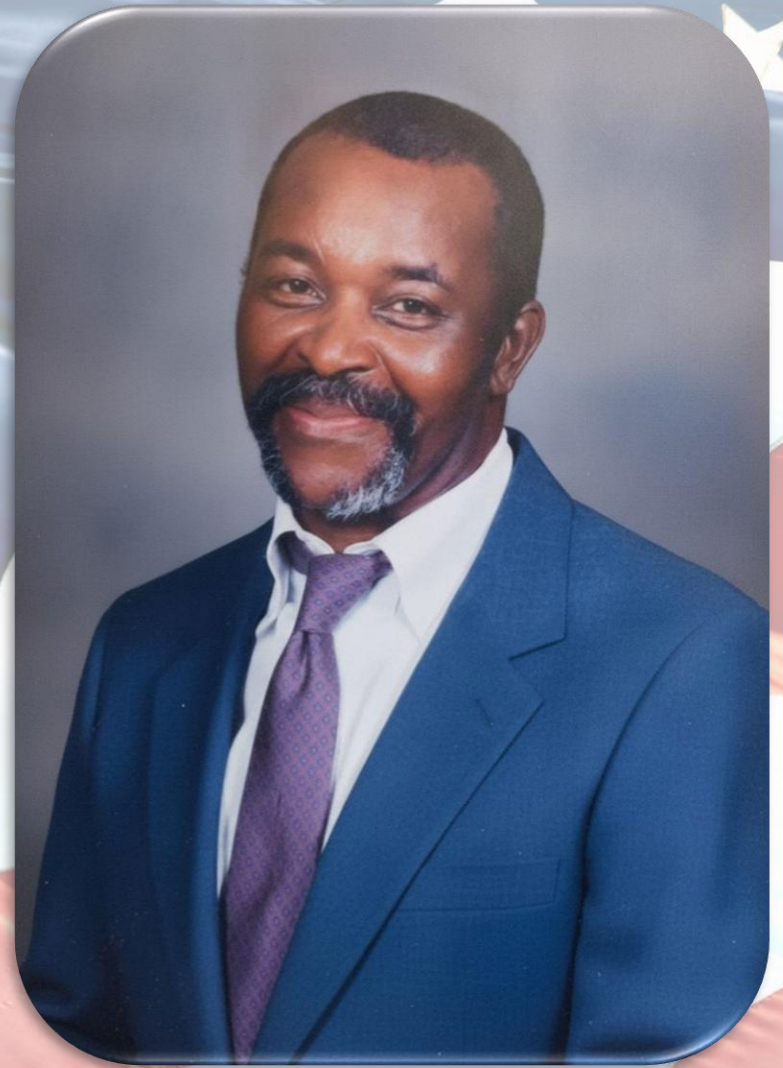
