David S. Evan passed away on Saturday, July 29, 2017 at Timberwood Court in Albany, OR.

David was born October 18, 1937 in Minnesota Lake, MN to Stephen and Balbina (Maday) Evan. He graduated from Minnesota Lake High School where he played basketball. After graduation, David worked for Walter Stencil from 1955 to 1957. He then enlisted in the Army and spent time at Fort Chaffee, AR and Fort Leonard Wood, MO. He served in the 5th Eng. Combat Company.

David was released and went back to work for Walter until September 1961. He went to work for a masonry contractor at St. Paul Minnesota. In October, David first received a letter from the Army to report to Fort Lewis, Washington. This was at the time of the Berlin crisis and David was one of the first to fill in with the 1022nd Combat Engineers (a National Guard unit) from Powell, Wyoming.

David was released in August of 1962 and moved to Salem, OR. He did masonry work for three years and then went to work for the Oregon Highway Department. It was at that time that he met Anna D. Schlyper. They were married in July of 1966.

In 1968, David went to work at Oregon State University doing building maintenance and remodeling projects. In 1970, he and Anna moved to Albany and built their home. In 1992, he moved into a carpenter's position at the university before retiring in June 1997.
