When you awaken in the morning's hush,

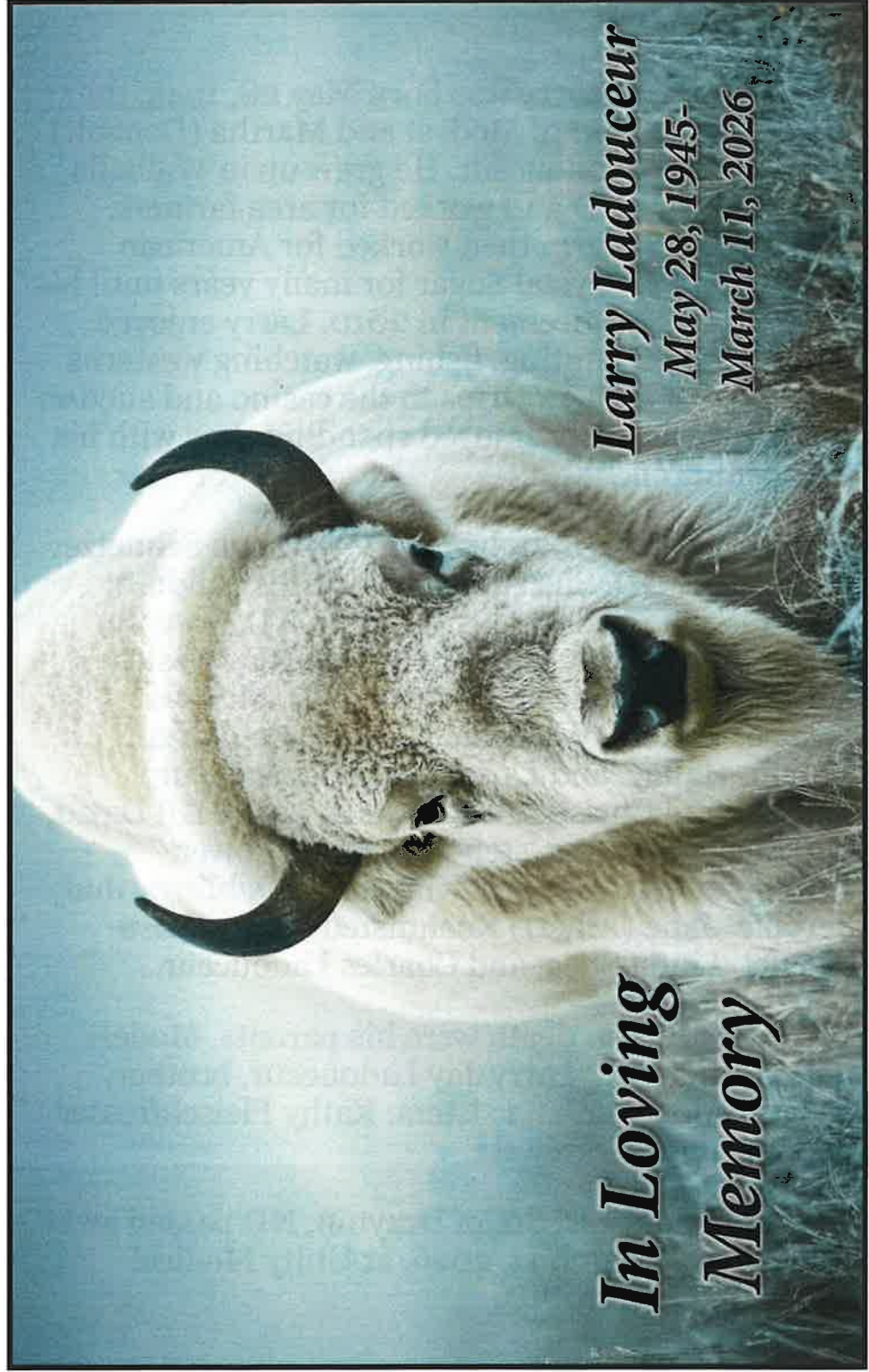
I am the swift uplifting rush...
