But celebrate my life

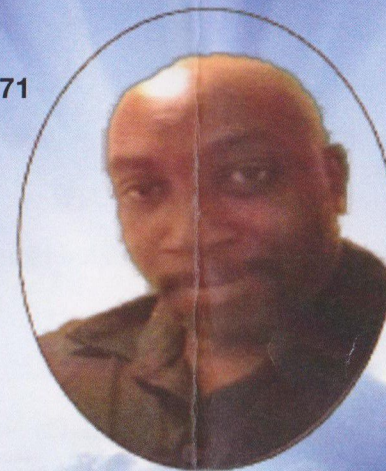
