Pastor Vance N. Dean, born in Cincinnati, Ohio, on May 19, 1960, to John H. Dean Sr. and Wilma Jean Dean, departed this life on September 25, 2024, at 64, after a lengthy battle with illness. Pastor Dean was an accomplished chess player at Hughes High School and the University of Cincinnati Chess Club, and briefly pursued standup comedy. Following his early commitment to Christ, he entered the ministry in the 2000s, receiving ordination in 2002 under Apostle Norman L. Rolling Sr. at Powerhouse of Deliverance. He decided to take his ministry to the streets by becoming a Street Pastor, alongside his wife Pastor Peggy Dean, he provided spiritual support through hospital and prison visits, baptisms, weddings, and ordinations. Their residence served as a hub for spiritual guidance and pastoral training. Following his early commitment to Christ, he entered the ministry in the 2000s, receiving ordination in 2002 under Apostle Norman L. Rolling Sr. at Powerhouse of Deliverance.
