


# IN LOVING MEMORY

*Son of Easline Brown of Murrels Inlet, South Carolina and Tom Collins of Sandy Island, South Carolina. Jacob was born on July 8, 1937 in Murrels Inlet, SC. He was called home to glory on November 13, 2023.*

*He was the youngest of six siblings: Ella Carr, currently living in Maryland, and four siblings who preceded him in death; Willie Brown, Lorenzer Bethea, Sarah Lewis and Mary Harvey. Jacob attended Howard High School in Georgetown, SC, where he was a member of the bus drivers club. After graduating from high school he moved to Baltimore, MD in July 1956. Shortly after arriving in Baltimore, Jacob met and married Barbara Ann Lumpkins (Bobbie). From this union, four children were born: Tyrone, Jacqueline, Kevin (preceding him in death), and Montressa. Jacob had a strong work ethic that was witnessed by his children. He worked at Maryland Paper Box Company until the company closed. He then worked at G. Heileman Brewing Company while also held two part time jobs as a cab driver and at MCQ Liquors. He worked as a custodian at Howard County Public School System until his retirement in 2007. His retired life included fishing trips, hanging out with friends at Lexington Market, and sitting in his "corner office" on the front porch of his home in Edmondson Village.*

*Jacob never lost his love for South Carolina. He continued to drive back "home" countless times over the years to visit family and friends. He maintained a subscription to "At the Beach" newspaper from Georgetown, SC. On visits back to Murrels Inlet, Jacob often attended church service at Browns Chapel United Methodist Church.*

*Jacob joined Shiloh Christian Community Church in Baltimore in the 1980's and was a member until his peaceful passing. He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife of sixty-one years, Barbara; one son, Tyrone Collins, two daughters, Dr. Jacqueline King and Montressa Bishop, a bonus daughter, Shahidah Miles; a daughter-in-law, Phyllis Collins; seven grandchildren: Rachel, Sterling, Demi, Trina, Jordan, Brandon, Taylor; seven great grandchildren; one sister, Ella Carr; two sisters-in-law, two brothers-in-law, countless nieces, nephews, and friends.*






