MY DEAR COUSIN VLADIMIR,

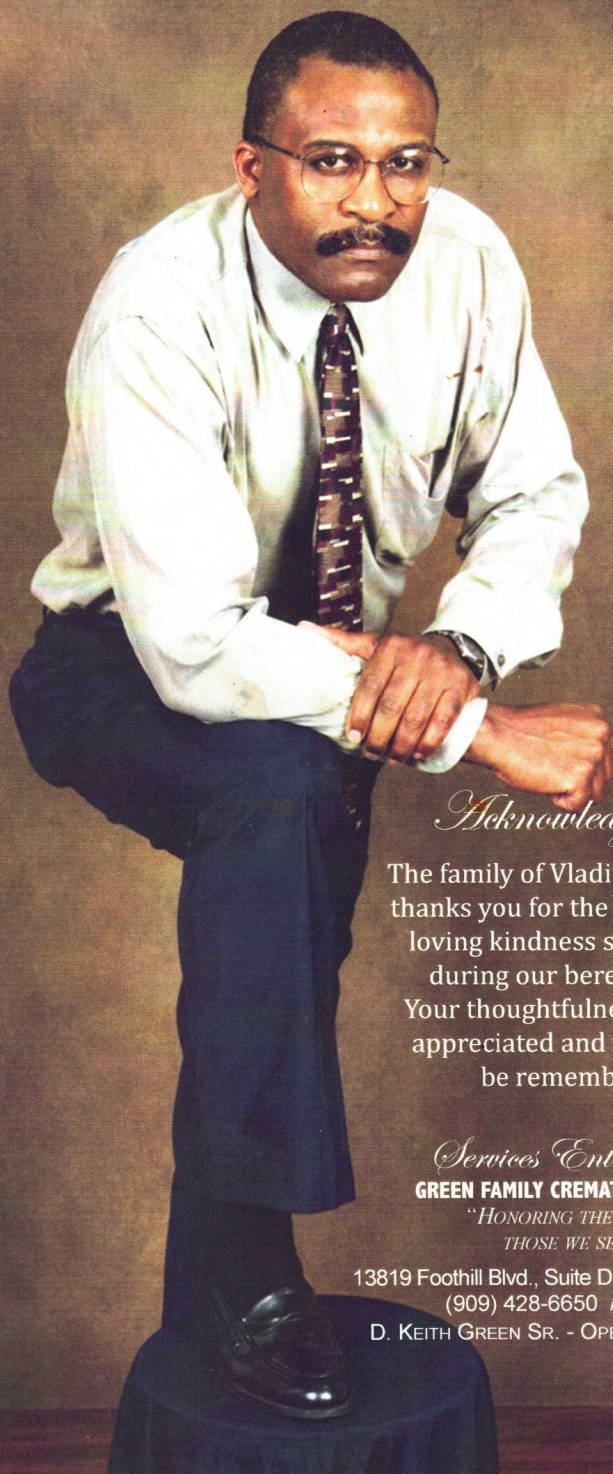
