

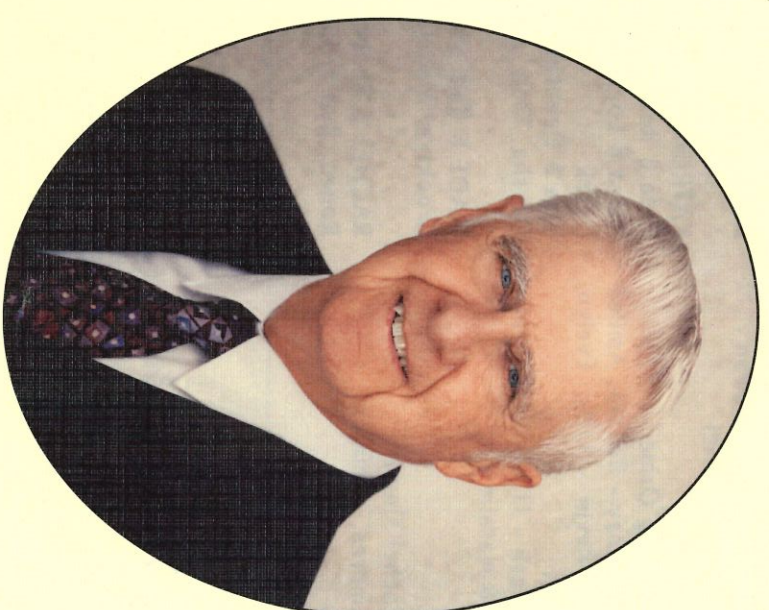
*A Heartfelt Poem to Barbara*
