no matter how small.


Go on with your life,

Mr. Kelvin Green was born on March 31, 1961, in Columbia, South Carolina. He was the youngest son of the late Henry Green Sr. and Elise Neal Green. He transitioned this earthy life on Tuesday, September 16, 2025. He attended Faith Tabernacle, The Way of The Cross COGIC Church growing up, where he was baptized and early on accepted Christ Jesus as his Lord and Savior.

In his youth, Kelvin was educated in the public schools of Richland County, SC. He attended Eau Claire High School in Columbia, South Carolina and The US Job Corps training in Texas. Kelvin started his work employment alongside his late father Henry Green Sr., (who at the time was self-employed) for many years learning the trades and all aspects of construction work. Before his illness, he was employed with The Addison Community Care Home, where he found his calling as a caregiver.
