Grace (Schober) Walz, 88, died on Saturday, December 21, 2024 in Jamestown, ND.

Grace was born on December 30, 1935, on a farm east of Jud in the township of Raney, ND, the daughter of Herman and Emma (Nitschke) Schober. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church. She attended school in Jud, where she excelled both academically and on the kittenball field.
