

GOD'S GARDEN

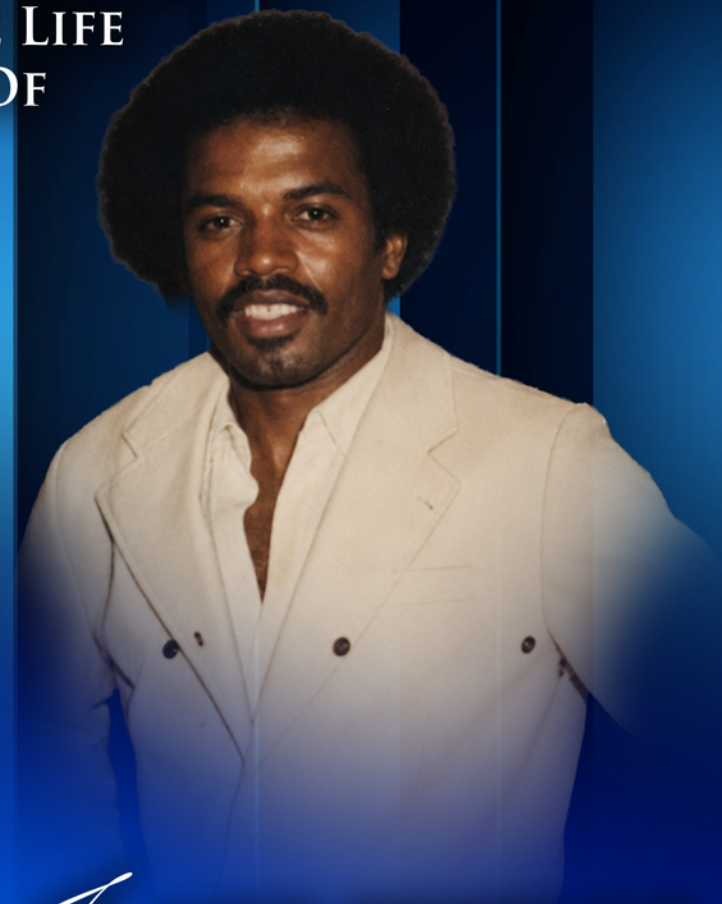
*God looked around His garden
