He and his brother made it a priority to fish and garden, not only for themselves but to share their harvest with the community. It brought them great joy, as giving was truly a part of who he was.

Brother Harold Logerman Sr. lived a life of purpose and service, a true servant of God whose legacy will continue to inspire future generations.

Brother Harold Logerman Sr. departed this life on March 22, 2026, at 12:55 p.m. at his home in Baldwin, Louisiana. He leaves to cherish his memory his last surviving sibling, Lawrence Logerman of San Francisco, California.
