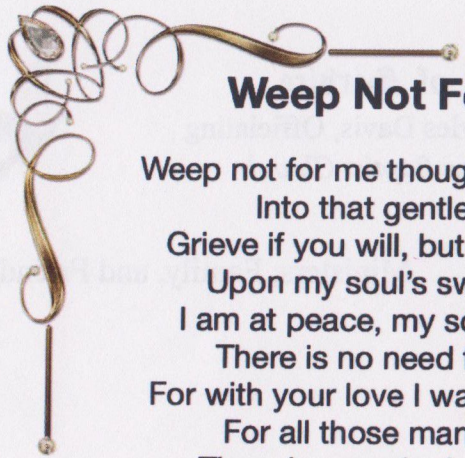




Weep Not For Me
