Born on February 3, 1965, Deene Grant peacefully departed this life on June 2, 2026.

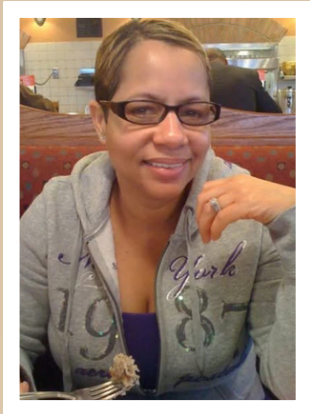
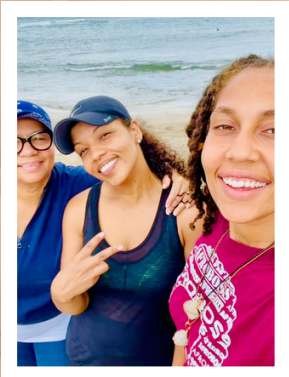
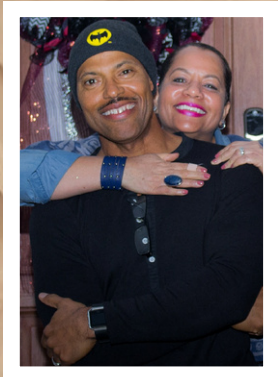
