Dear Friends and Family, Today we gather not in mourning, but in joyful remembrance of a man who turned every moment into a memory: Ca'Shawn LaMar Carter.

With deep sorrow, we announce the passing of Ca'Shawn, who left us at the young age of 32. Born on October 6, 1993, at Harbor General Hospital in Torrance, California, to Carmen D. Jones and Casey LaMar Carter, Ca'Shawn entered the world as the eighth child in a big, loving family, surrounded by the energy, joy, and lessons that shaped him into the man he became.

Ca'Shawn spent his younger years living in Torrance, Los Angeles, San Bernardino, and for a time lived with his grandmother Vera, continuing school in Inglewood. He later lived in Portland, OR, and Victorville, before making his permanent move to Las Vegas, where he reunited with his mother and siblings and eventually built his life, his family, and his legacy.

Born with Marfan Syndrome, a rare genetic disorder, Ca'Shawn learned early what it meant to face life's challenges with courage. This shaped him into natural-born fighter — someone who moved through the world with resilience, determination, and a strength that inspired everyone who knew him.

As a baby, Ca'Shawn loved candy so much — but he couldn't say the word "candy," so he would say "Nonny." His Auntie Debbie lovingly gave him the nickname Nonny, and he grew into that name proudly, carrying it with him all the way into adulthood.

As a child, Ca'Shawn had a bright, unforgettable personality. One of the funniest memories his family holds close is how much he hated getting his hair combed. The moment the comb came out, he would cry out dramatically for help — calling the name of every single person he knew, hoping someone would rescue him.

From childhood into adulthood, Ca'Shawn was full of energy that couldn't be contained. His contagious laugh could shift the mood of an entire room, pulling others into joy with him — an energy he definitely passed on to his kids.

He was sharp, observant, and quick-witted, always paying attention to the details others might miss. He loved learning new things and was always open to positive advice from family and friends. Ca'Shawn was a very outgoing person, someone who And he had a true hustler's spirit — he loved making money, staying motivated, and finding ways to provide for the people he loved.

Ca'Shawn also took great pride in his appearance, always carrying himself with a sharp sense of style. Whether he was stepping out for a family gathering or just going about his day, he presented himself with confidence, intention, and a look that was unmistakably his own. Ca'Shawn enjoyed rap music, and in his time away from home he loved spending time at the casino — a place where he could unwind. In 2017, Ca'Shawn met the love of his life, Lesley Mazon. Their connection was immediate and deep. Through their relationship, Ca'Shawn quickly became a devoted father to Manny and Mia, embracing them with the same love and pride he carried for everything that mattered to him. Together, Ca'Shawn and Lesley welcomed three more beautiful children — Ca'Shawn "C.J." Jr., Carmiana, and Cashley — completing a family that became the center of his world.

He loved spending time with his family in the simplest, most meaningful ways — playing video games with his kids and brother-in-love, swimming with the kids, and taking them to the park and playground. For movie nights, he always reached for horror or comedy, laughing loud and fully in the moment with the people he loved most.

Among his greatest joys in life were his six wonderful children: Cy'na, Manny, Mia, C.J., Carmiana, and Cashley. He loved them deeply, and each of them carries a piece of his light forward.

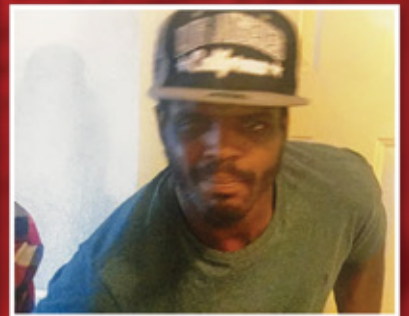
For work, Ca'Shawn served as an OTC Greeter for Westgate Resorts, a role that fit him perfectly because he was truly a people person. His warmth, charisma, and natural ability to make others feel welcome helped him excel — he made the Top 10 Greeters list three times within a single year.
