Kenneth E. White was born on December 18, 1959, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to the late Raymond Frank White and Mary Elizabeth White. He peacefully passed away on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, at Einstein Hospital in Philadelphia, PA, after a courageous battle with diabetes.

Kenneth received his early education in Philadelphia and graduated from Olney High School. He later attended Community College of Philadelphia, where he earned an Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice, and went on to complete a Bachelor's Degree in Business from Gwynedd Mercy University.
