Jerry Edward Brosch, 78, of Sedalia, MO, passed away on Friday, March 7, 2025, at Bothwell Regional Health Center. He was born on June 5, 1946, in Sedalia, MO, to Norbert Leo Brosch and Mildred M. (Wenig) Pfletcher, who preceded him in death.
