I then most humbly pray,

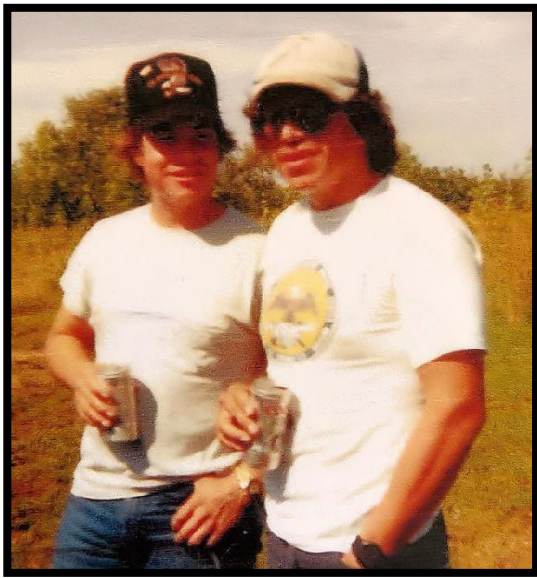
When in the Lord's safe landing net,
