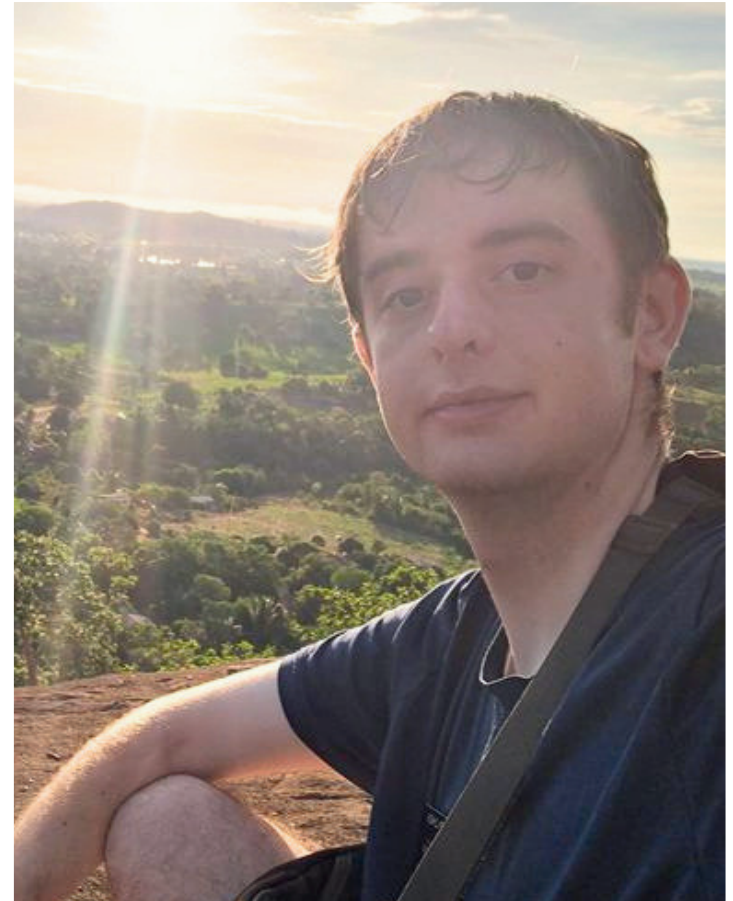
Though his time on earth was far too short, Andrew's faith, example, and love will continue to inspire those who knew him. He will be deeply missed and forever cherished.
