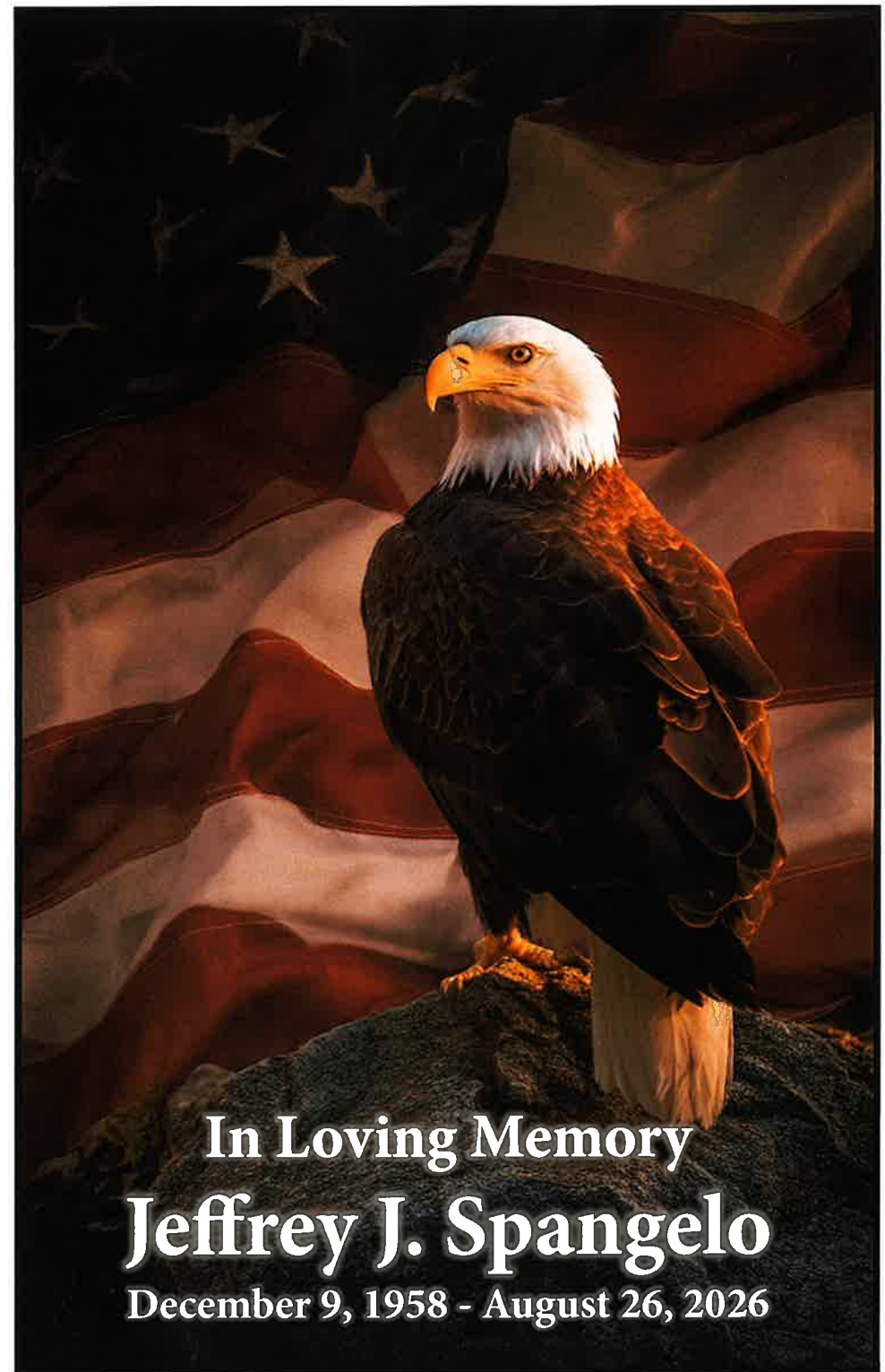
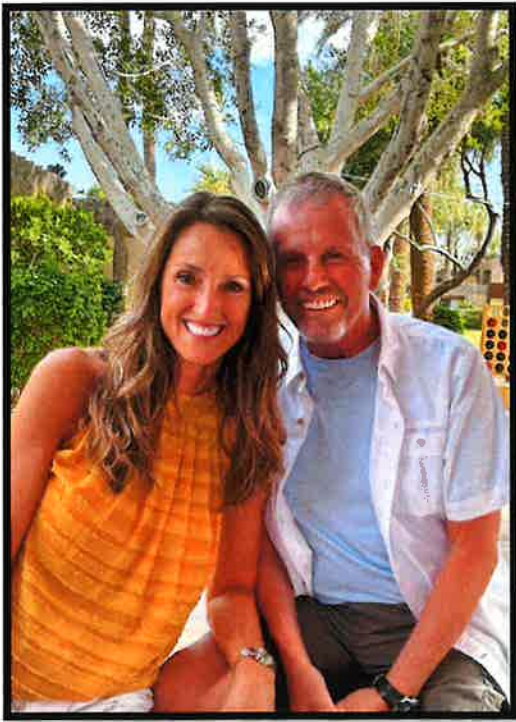




In Loving Memory

Jeff was born on December 9, 1958 in Cavalier, ND to Fredrick "Wayne" Spangelo and Beverly Anne "Unke" Spangelo. Jeff grew up in rural Hensel, ND and attended Hensel and Cavalier Public Schools, and graduated from Cavalier High School in 1977.

A proud veteran of the United States Air Force, Jeff honorably served his country for 20 years and 21 days. He truly enjoyed being with the love of his life on many, many awesome adventures. He was at his happiest being on a beach somewhere and going on long, epic jeep drive adventures with Kristi, or kicking back in the backyard enjoying the sunshine. During his spare time, he loved playing riveting and highly competitive games of Yahtzee while listening to Kristi's random playlists, as well as reading and watching movies with Kristi.
