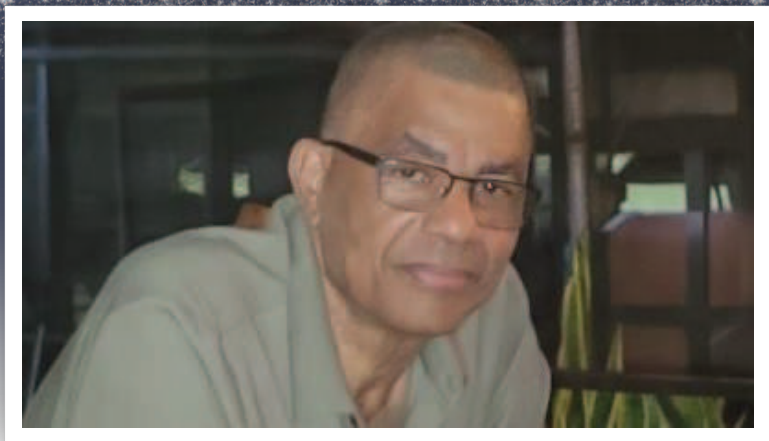




ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS & REPASS
