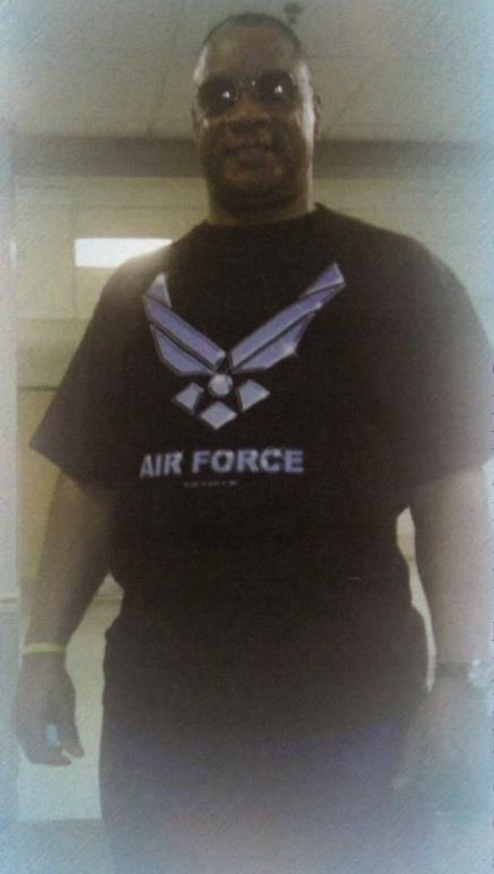

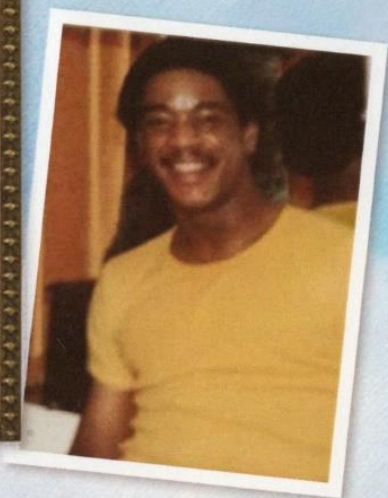
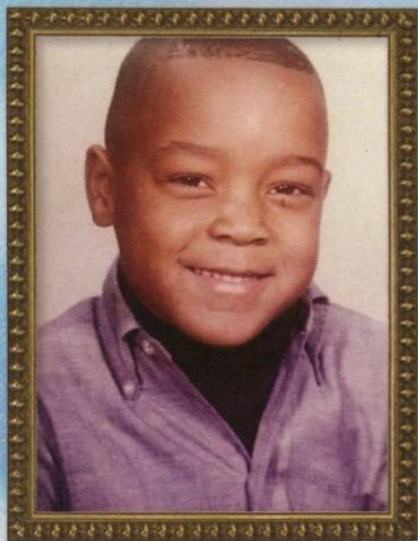


## OBITUARY

Carlos Lopp, 66, of Coatesville, Pennsylvania, passed away on Friday, July 10, 2026, at the VA Medical Center in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
