


For my Stepdad who became my dad

right by my side.


A Letter To My Brother


Terry's kindness, laughter, and love for people will be deeply missed by all who knew him. His memory will live on through the lives he touched and the warmth he shared with everyone around him.


WHEN I MUST LEAVE YOU

And never, never be afraid to die, For I am waiting for you in the sky!*


