

## **Albert Philip Weiss**



When Albert was 9 months old the family moved to Meade County and the Maass Ranch on Pine Creek was purchased. Albert attended West Pine School and graduated the 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Albert stayed on the ranch and herded sheep and raised Black Angus cattle. On November 2, 1946, Albert married Mazy Miller of Maurine, SD. They lived on the Weiss home ranch for the next 60 years. They celebrated their 63rd anniversary in 2009. Because of failing health Albert & Mazy lived with their daughter, Rosa Jean and Jim Hendricks, in Littleton, CO, for 3-1/2 years, and the last 6 months he lived near daughter, Coretta and Rod Anderson, as a resident of the Golden Living Center, Ipswich, SD.
