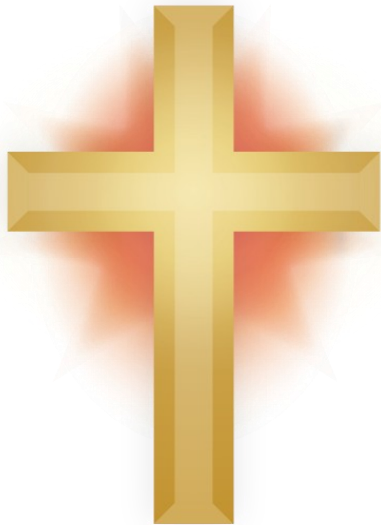
Educated in the public schools of Sumter County, where he attended Sumter High school and went on to spend years working as Hydro blaster inches Sumter area.
