

Former Shawnee resident Fred "Jim " Lynn, Jr., 89, passed away Sunday, February 11, 2024 in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

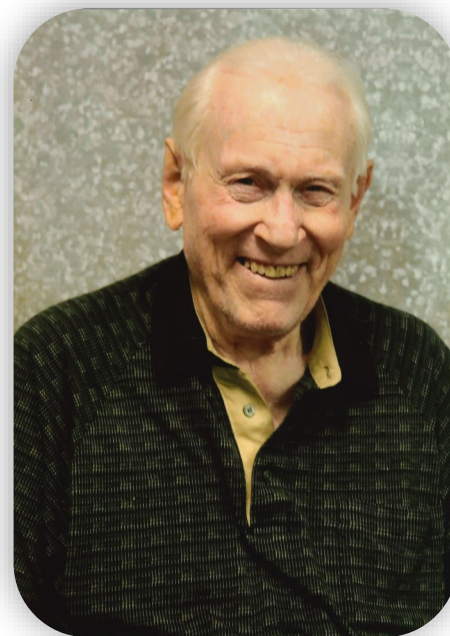
He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, and his aunt, Margaret and grandparents, Ebbin and Mayme who raised him.
