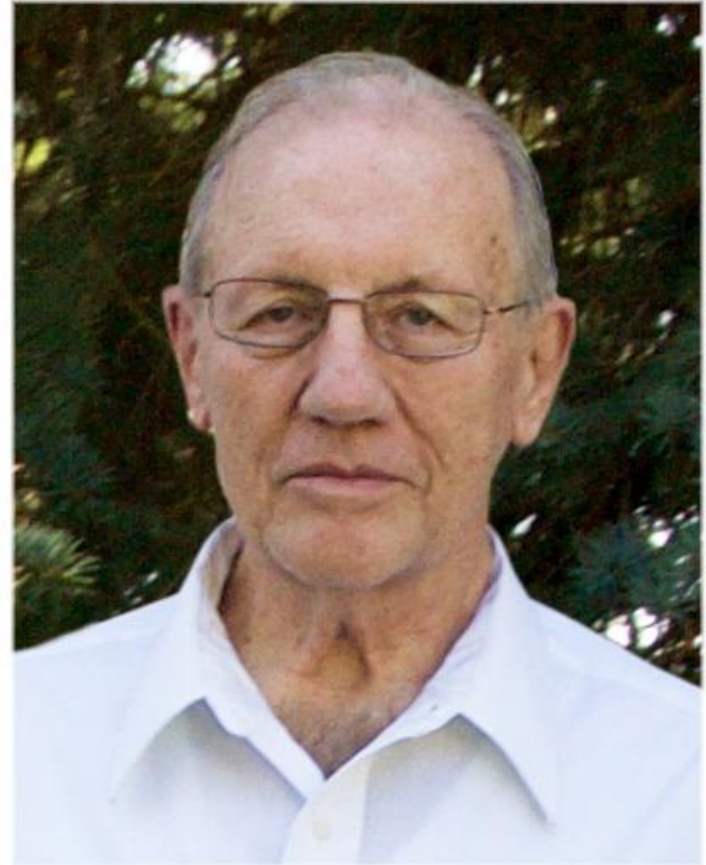


He is Gone
