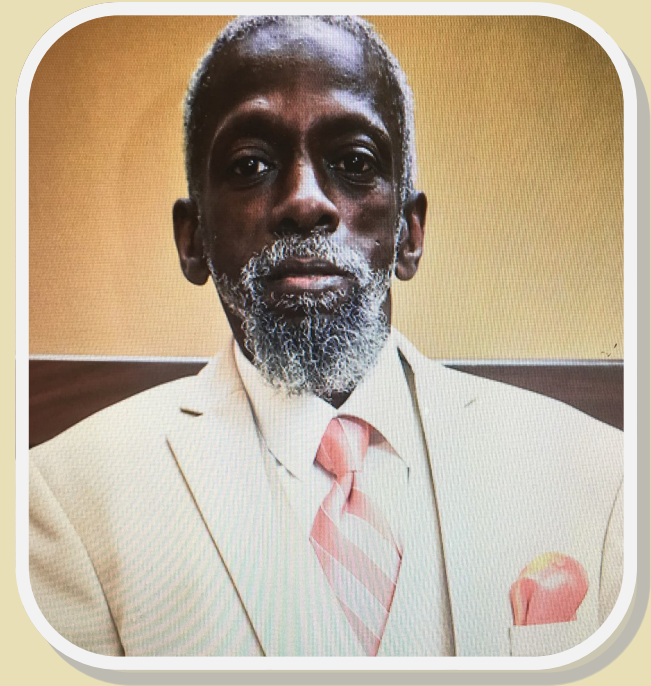

Obituary

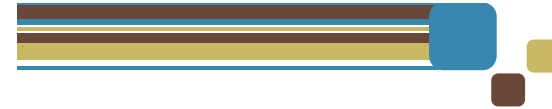
