Obituary

ANTHONY (Tony) STEVERSON, age 62, of Neptune Township, NJ was taken into God’s care on Sunday morning, September 4, 2016 at his home. The son of Alexander Steversen and Mary [Jones] Steversen, Tony was born on June 8, 1954 in Warrenton, North Carolina. He was the third of five children.

Tony attended Long Branch school system graduating from Long Branch High School in 1973. He attended Middletown North Vocational School for electronics during his junior and senior year of high school. After high school, he attended Brick Computer Science Institute specializing in electronics and computer systems. Around that time, he started his career working for Strong Alarm Company. He went on to work for Perkin Elmer (later becoming Concurrent) for several years. Afterwards, he started his own security system company, Vertronixx, which much later evolved to his current company, Cyber Strong, Inc.

Tony began playing drums in his first band at the age of 12. Over the past five decades, Tony played in multiple bands as the drummer, percussionist, bass guitar player and/or lead or backup vocalist. Tony was a member of a number of bands: The Crystalations, To Be Continued, Freakquency Unknown, Token, Solar, Smooth Touch, Split Decision, The No Regretts Band and The Secrett Band. Tony was a member of the Red Bank Elks Bates Lodge #220 and member of the Neptune Democratic Club.
