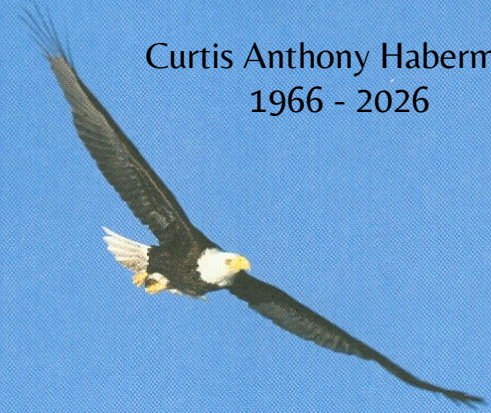
Curt will be remembered for being the quiet one, with a kind heart, a good sense of humor, and a stubborn streak.
