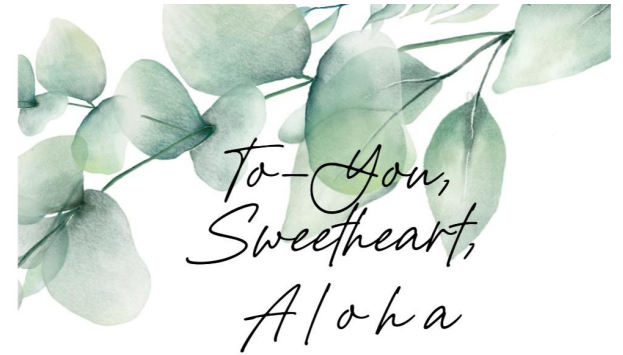

peace and strength.





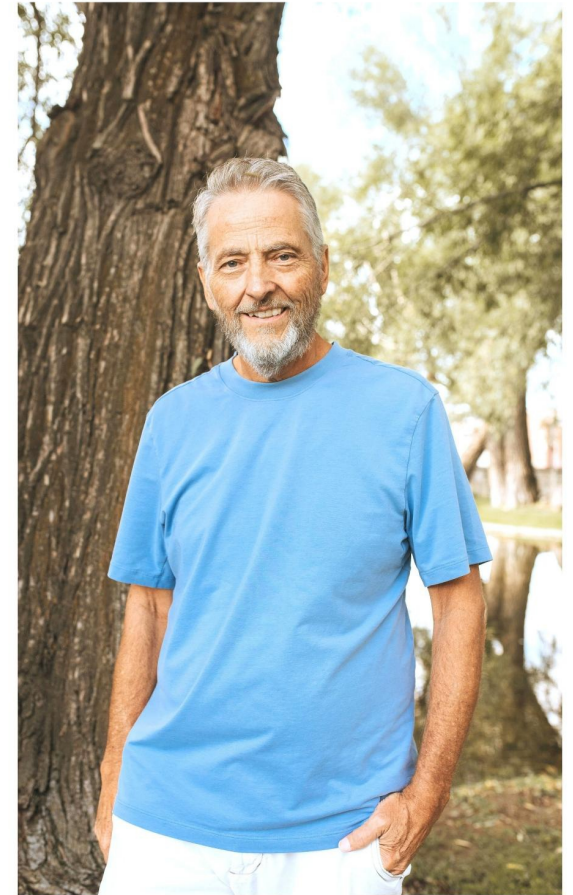
