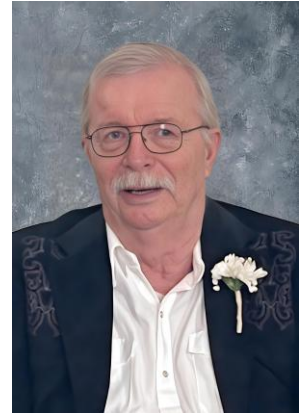


James A. Blemke
