He worked there as a software project manager until his retirement in 2007.

Keith was active in his church, serving as choir director/worship leader and also on elder boards. His musical inclinations inspired him to play his trumpet throughout high school and in the CSU marching band. He could always be found humming a tune and couldn't wait to see Jesus playing that horn to welcome him home. Keith's highest priority, passion, and commitment was to serve Jesus Christ and to love and care for his family, in which he took great pride.

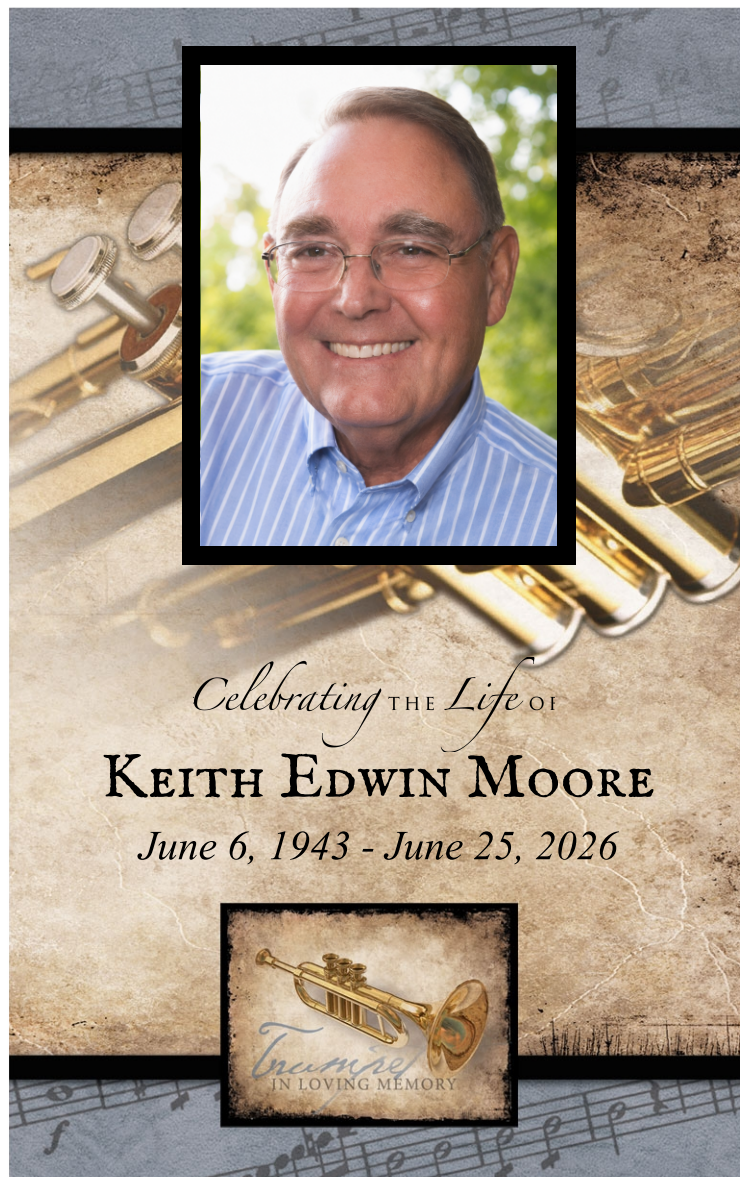
Keith was preceded in death by his parents, Henry and Evelyn.
