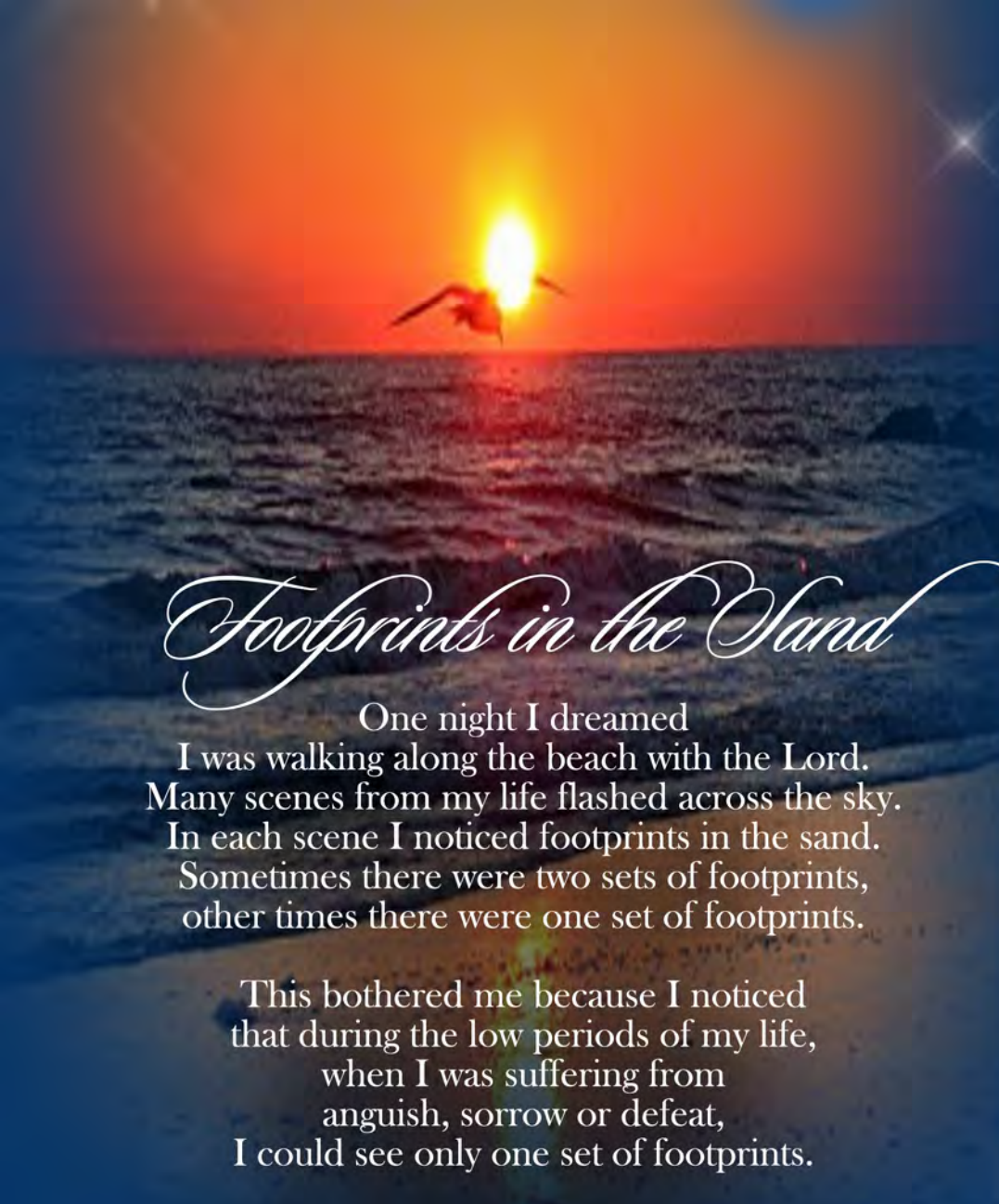




Footprints in the Sand
