

Keva spent many days hospitalized but she managed to touch lives through her Testimony. She kept a smile on her face and encouraged many others. Keva enjoyed marching bands as she was a member of The Go Getters and Baltimore All Stars.

Keva was baptised at a young age (Baltimore Outreach). She received her education from Baltimore City Schools and graduated from Baltimore City College. Keva attended BCCC and received her certification in Early Childhood Education. She obtained her own Day Care Center because loved kids. Keva loved to travel, being outside and lived her life to the fullest. Keva loved her children, family and always wanted everyone to come together. She was a hustler for REAL!

Keva loved dancing (Speaker Queens at the Paradox, Sisters 4 Life- she enjoyed Hip Hop and Spiritual dancing.) She was employed at the Maryland Department of Transportation, Maryland Transit Administration as a Bus Cleaner, The Baltimore City Circuit Court as a Clerical Licensed Clerk, Magic Minds (Summer Camp) as a Dance, Education and Resource Teacher. Keva had a relationship with Peer 2 Peer Mentoring & Personal Development Program and the Lupus Foundation. She created her own dance team called "Rising Stars." Keva loved talking on the phone and was definitely Fox 45 News. She was a funny, loving, kind, caring, giving, motivating, smart, encouraging, fighting WARRIOR!
