Ann Marie attended Cheyney University where she obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Education. She received her Elementary Certification from the University of Pennsylvania.



After retiring, she spent time engaged in many activities such as drawing, jewelry making, knitting, computer classes, and a host of other activities.


Ann Marie was touched by God while she simply slept, and was called from labor to reward on June 10, 2023.




Ann Marie was preceded in death by her husband, Vincent; parents Frank Sr. and Myrtle Manning; and her brother Frank Jr.
